

Download Give Me Liberty Or Give Me Death

“Give me Liberty, or give me Death!” (deutsch: „Gebt mir Freiheit oder gebt mir den Tod!“) ist der Schlusssatz einer Rede von Patrick Henry vor der Virginia Convention, der in die amerikanische Geschichte einging. "Give me liberty, or give me death!" is a quotation attributed to Patrick Henry from a speech he made to the Second Virginia Convention on March 23, 1775, at St. John's Church in Richmond, Virginia. To avoid interference from Lieutenant-Governor Dunmore and his Royal Marines, the Second Virginia Convention met March 20, 1775 inland at Richmond--in what is now called St. John's Church--instead of the Capitol in Williamsburg. Words from a speech by Patrick Henry urging the American colonies to revolt against England. Henry spoke only a few weeks before the Revolutionary War began: “Gentlemen may cry Peace, Peace, but there is no peace. - Give Me Liberty Or Give Me Death
