The Chicago Defender, Tribune, Sun and Times, and Daily News dominated twentieth-century Chicago newspapering. The weekly Chicago Defender, founded by Robert S. Abbott in 1905, was the nation's most powerful African American newspaper in its first two decades, covering racism sensationally, advocating rights for blacks, and offering a beacon of hope for migrants from the South.
