The Katyn massacre (Polish: zbrodnia katyńska, "Katyń crime"; Russian: ?????????? ?????? Katynskaya reznya, "Katyn massacre", or Russian: ?????????? ??????????, "Katyn execution by shooting") was a series of mass executions of Polish military officers and intelligentsia carried out by the Soviet Union, specifically the NKVD ("People's Commissariat for Internal ...").

"Musée des Beaux Arts" (French for "Museum of Fine Arts") is a poem written by W. H. Auden in December 1938 while he was staying in Brussels, Belgium, with Christopher Isherwood. It was first published under the title "Palais des beaux arts" (Palace of Fine Arts) in the Spring 1939 issue of *New Writing*, a modernist magazine edited by John Lehmann.
