Samuel Langhorne Clemens (November 30, 1835 – April 21, 1910), well known by his pen name Mark Twain, was an American author and humorist. Twain is noted for his novels *Adventures of Huckleberry Finn* (1884), which has been called "the Great American Novel," and *The Adventures of Tom Sawyer* (1876). He also wrote poetry, short stories, essays, and non-fiction. The *Autobiography of Mark Twain* refers to a lengthy set of reminiscences, dictated, for the most part, in the last few years of American author Mark Twain's life and left in typescript and manuscript at his death. The *Autobiography* comprises a rambling collection of anecdotes and ruminations rather than a conventional autobiography. Twain never compiled these writings and dictations into a ...But we are all insane, anyway.
